Schedule of Classes –FALL 2011

Classes are on a first come, first served basis. All classes that are **bold** are at my house in Lake Forest. Those I am teaching at quilt shops are as follows:

Although I don't require advanced payment for classes at my house, you must cancel 72 hours prior to the class or you are responsible for payment. The following are the descriptions of the classes that I am teaching. To enroll in a shop class, you must contact the shop. Phone numbers are above. Classes at my house on weekdays start at 9:30 and on weekends at 9 unless otherwise stated.

- 1. U.F.O.** – Here is your chance to have help on one of those projects that you got stuck on. Or maybe, you just want to set aside a day to catch up. I will be there to help with whatever you might need. 1 day. \$25.00
- 2. Caring and Sharing** – This is a session to work on charity quilts. There is no fee, but you must be working on a charity quilt. It can go to anyone and you can use your fabric and pattern or use my fabrics
- 3. TESSELLATED LEAVES** – this scrap quilt is made up of 14 different leaf fabrics that are tessellated to fit into each other for a striking fall quilt. Lyn has done all the math so you just follow her chart and snowball the pieces for an easy to sew together. Contact shop.
- 4. MYSTERY** – For this class you will receive a supply list with values and amounts. You will cut strips of each fabric according to that list. In class you will sew a clue at a time until I can't keep it a secret any longer. 1 ½ days \$45.00 – my house and shop
- 5. SKEWED TWICE** – For this quilt you will make a small 9 patch which we will “skew” with a special template and then it is placed in the center of a larger 9 patch which we will also “skew” to give the illusion of a very wacky chain. These blocks will be alternated with a focus block and then the entire quilt will be finished with a “skewed” border for that final finishing touch. My house \$30 plus template fees. Or contact shop.
- 7. SKEWS MY STARS** – for this class we will make star blocks that alternate fabrics and values and then “skew” them with a special template to give them a kinky look. These will be made into a border to put on any fun fabric. 1 day \$30.00 plus template fee.
- 8. CELTIC CROWN** – for this quilt we will use half-square triangle papers and a flying geese tru-up to make this great looking quilt. A single large block would make an adorable baby quilt. Must see to appreciate. Contact shop.
- 9. FUNKY CHICKEN** - In this class we will make some 9 patches and then using a special tool we will "skew" them to make a funky border. . Then we will audition fabrics for your choices for the Chicken. I will help anyone that needs help on figuring out how to do machine applique. The appliqué could also be done by hand. Contact shop
- 10. OH MY STARS IT'S FALL** – This is a fun scrap quilt that has a leaf in the center of a star. Can be done in fall colors or anything else that you wish. 1 day - \$30.

- 11. CHARMED – WOVEN STAR** – I am going to do a series of charm quilts in which we will make a pattern out of a single template shape that is rotary cut. This is a way to use up that stash that we all have. Each month I will feature a different shape. \$30.00 plus \$6.00 template fee'
- 12. RIBBONS AND BOWS** – another great way to use up scraps. You will rotary cut the single template piece and then sew together in several different configurations to get the look of ribbons and bows. So easy, so fun. 1 day - \$30.00 plus \$6.00 template fee.
- 13 BOUNTIFUL BATIKS.** – looking for a fun scrap quilt to use up all those batik (or whatever else you choose)_ fabrics? This quilt uses a simple block that forms a chain. You can set it a variety of ways. Very fast! Contact shop
- 14. FALL FESTIVAL** – this is a great scrap quilt that uses lots of fall fabrics to make some pointy leaves that look like they are falling from the sky. We will use the 60° ruler for ease in cutting. Contact Shop
- 15. WACKY WED** – this scrap quilt uses lots of a single color in lites and darks. By snowballing, we will create an uneven star. Then we will finish it off by skewing it with a special template to make it look even wackier. You'll love it. Contact Shop
- 16. FRENCH BRAID** - this is another stash buster quilt. Using an acrylic template for ease in cutting, we will sew up rows to look like braiding. Very simple. Could also be used for a border. 1 day \$30.00 plus template.
- 17. GIFT WRAPPED** - a very simple quilt that uses 'snowballing' for ease in piecing. The complete quilt will remind you of bows on a present. Great in Christmas fabrics for anything else. Contact shop
- 18. SANTA CLAWS IS COMING** – this fun version of a trip around the world quilt uses just 7 fabrics and a series of 9 patch blocks to form the pattern. Once the blocks are completed we will skew them with a special template to give it a whole new look. Contact shop.
